### 2. Purpose of data processing

In order for us to be able to treat you, we must create a patient record and process your personal data (master data and health data). This not only required by law, but it is indispensable for the quality of treatment. Health data that is protected by law includes, for example, treatment information collected by us and other physicians, medical history, diagnoses, and therapy suggestions.

An overview of the underlying legal bases for processing their data can be found in the Annex.

We only transfer your personal data to third parties if this is permitted by law or if you have consented.

### 3. Data Security

Your data is stored and processed only in the practice in a multilayer secured network. This patient network is separated from the internet network and the waiting room hotspot. In the case of data transmission, e.g. to a laboratory, your data is encrypted and thus well secured against unauthorized access by third parties.

### 4. Recipients of your data

In the course of the treatment, we may cooperate with other doctors, psychotherapists and other service providers, to whom we also have to transmit your personal data. These include, for example, laboratories with which we collaborate to obtain certain values (e.g. the blood fat acids values) that we need for treatment and diagnosis. In addition, there are legal requirements for cooperation with your health insurance, the medical service of health care, and medical associations. In individual cases, we transmit the data to other eligible recipients with your consent.

### 5. Your rights

Based on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) you have the right to

- Obtain information about the personal data concerning you,
- To have incorrect data corrected,
- Under certain conditions, to request the deletion or limitation of the processing of your personal data. Please note: We will only keep your patient records for as long as necessary for the treatment and to comply with the legal requirements.
- To object to processing of your data,
- To have your data transferred to other designated recipients. This requires a separate consent.

As far as you have agreed to the transmission of your data, you have the right to revoke the consent for the future transmission.

We like to point out that any further treatment may no longer be possible in the case of withdrawal of consent.

You have the right to contact the relevant data protection supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data is not lawful. The address of the supervisory authority responsible for us is

### Annex

Legal basis for data processing in medical practice

- The legal basis for the processing of data is Article 9 (2) lit. h) GDPR in conjunction with § 22 (1) No. 1 lit. b) Federal Data Protection Act and the treatment contract according to § § 630 FF BGB, § 10 para 1 mbo-ä, § 57 para. 3 BMV-Ä.
- Legal bases for transmission to other physicians are the treatment contract and § 73 Para 1b SGB V for the purpose of/Weiter-Behandlung and documentation of treatment.
- Legal bases for transfers to the medical Association are in particular § § 294 ff. SGB V; § § 12, 106 SGB V; § 295 paragraph 1a sgb v; § § 298, 299 SGB V for the following purposes:
  - Billing of medical services
  - Payroll Check
  - Quality Assurance
  - Profitability Assessment
  - Legally required forwarding of data by the Medical Association to the responsible health insurance company.
- Legal bases for transmission to health insurance companies are in particular § § 294 ff. SGB V, § 291, paragraph 2b SGB V, § 36, para. 1 BMV-Ä (in the case of § 44 para 4 SGB V with your consent for the purpose of determining the entitlement to benefits in accordance with the directives regarding inability to work).
- Legal basis for the transmission to the medical service of health insurance is § 276 SGB V for the purpose of the examination, advice and assessment.

Furthermore, further data transmission obligations may arise from other legal requirements.
